**COMPETITION RULES**

1. NO ONE MAY COMPETE UNLESS S/HE IS IN APPROPRIATE HIGHLAND DRESS (i.e., HAT, TIE, JACKET OPTIONAL (WEATHER PERMITTING)), EXCEPTION: THOSE ENTERED IN GRADE V SOLO COMPETITION.
2. COMPETITORS MUST BE READY, WHEN CALLED, TO COMPETE OR WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
3. DECISIONS BY JUDGES AND STEWARDS WILL BE **FINAL**. THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ALTER OR CANCEL **ANY** EVENT.
4. ALL PIPING, DRUMMING AND BAND CONTESTS ARE CONDUCTED UNDER THE RULES OF THE EASTERN UNITED STATES PIPE BAND ASSOCIATION. THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISQUALIFY ANY COMPETITOR GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT.
5. EACH SNARE DRUMMING COMPETITOR MUST FURNISH HIS/HER OWN ACCOMPANIST. EACH TENOR OR BASS COMPETITOR MAY ONLY HAVE A MAXIMUM OF TWO PIPERS AND ONE SNARE DRUMMER.
6. BAND DRAWS ARE HELD AT 10 AM EACH DAY IN THE PIPING & DRUMMING REGISTRATION TENT.
7. ENTRY DEADLINE IS NOVEMBER 1, 2013. **NO FIELD ENTRIES. \$20 LATE FEE.**
8. ORDER OF PLAY FOR SOLO EVENTS WILL BE POSTED AT THE PIPING & DRUMMING TENT. CHECK IN WITH THE STEWARD BEFORE YOUR EVENT.
9. TRAVEL ALLOWANCE IS \$300 FOR THE FIRST FIVE TEXAS BANDS. THE FIRST OUT OF STATE BAND RECEIVES \$750 (WILL BE DETERMINED BY POSTMARK).
